

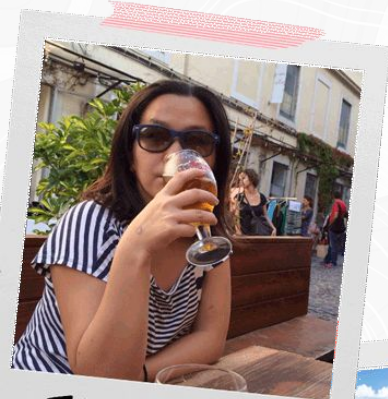
--o--The Occasional Traveller--o--
